Welcome to a course in traditional Swedish music!



During five intense days and nights we fill the 17th century castle Ekebyholm and the surroundings with approximately 90 "spelmän" (traditional musicians) from all over the world, in all ages. This is a unique opportunity for you to improve and develope your skills in Swedish traditional folk music.

The instructions will be given at all levels – participants range from beginners to professionals. Most play nyckelharpa, but there are also fiddlers. You will be taught individually, 30 minutes per day with the same teacher (Mon-Thu), as well as in smaller groups with different teachers. The lessons will be held without sheet music. We also sing traditional folk songs with Eva Tjörnebo.

In the evenings there are concerts with invited musicians, singing gatherings and great opportunities to play and dance together. The course will end with a final concert in Rimbo Church on Thursday at 7 PM.

The course "Låtkursen på Ekebyholm", began in 1976 with Eric Sahlström and Gösta Sandström, the most wellknown fiddler and nyckelharpa players and builders in the 20th century, as teachers.

Every year, the Eric Sahlström Memorial Fund awards a few young fiddlers between the ages 13–20 a scholarship. In addition to free admission to the course, it's a great honour to receive the Sahlström scholarship, and so far 107 people have received it.

Many of those return, both as participants and as teachers.
